しき そく ("Shiki Soku") is for singing koto player. It can be played without singing, but please sing if possible, using open vowel sounds of your choosing. Repeats are open, and the pauses can vary in length, so performance time could vary from between 5-8 minutes.

The title comes from the Heart Sutra: "shiki soku zeku ku soku zeshiki" (form is emptiness, emptiness is form)
